In Mill Valley, Carolyn Clark was well assisted by Bob Wallace, Darlene Crawford and Eugene Mallant, and Carolyn asked that we express her gratitude to Peggy Hewett from the Mill Valley Chamber of Commerce for making the key to the fountain faucet available for our use. Don won the 1980 Double Dipsea and for years wrote this post-race rehash - and this year's recruitee hopes that Don will resume his responsibilities next year

Actually, Russ' best ever was in 1978 when he finished 2nd in 1:49:07. Hope to see you regularly now Russ. First woman for the last three years was Florianne Harp who was just using the trail as a training course for the Pike's Peak Marathan later this summer.
