Darth works with many fine representatives from these organizations to insure co-ordination, co-operation, and safety. Yet another outstanding job Darth - a big thanks. Wait a sec., better thank Vicki - she's the boss of that family. Oops. Forgot to mention that Darth placed 165th, 2:15 in this years race...not too shabby for a guy who runs with scissors and light-saber.

Walter Stack is an ambulance chaser. Well, at least he should be, the way he loves to play with that siren on his bullhorn. He got his message across to the commuters, who by now know that the race is very close to start time. Messages aside, starter Larry Manit amassed 47 stop-watches, took a tranquilizer, and fired a cannon. Actually, he blew a whistle, but for the sake of exaggerated journalism, it's a cannon. Off they go, the first group - all the gals and Walt. No need to figure who planned that method of handicapping. Right, Walt? No wonder Walt takes his own sweet time on the trail.

Finally, all commuters are enroute on east-bound dirt. The starting line is vacant with the exception of Manit, 47 stop-watches and a retired cannon. All energy is now focused on finish line activity. Mary Magee helped keep expenses down by getting mega-cups donated.

Foxy Deborah Neil, aided by Shirley Crabbe and Valerie Hessen, was the official greeter and keeper of official race times as loud noises erupted from the finish line. In 1:48:51 p.c. (post-cannon), Russ Kiernan crossed the finish line. Hot on Russ' heels was 31 year old Butch Alexander who blew the old fastest actual time away with a time of 1:38:26, 3 min. 42 sec. faster than Miguel Tibaduize's 1980 time. First female, Peggy Smith, a 32 year old blonde bombshell, took 5 min. 43 sec. off of Florianne Harp's 1982 record and took 4th finisher honors. The other long-term record broken was for females 50 - 59, and Martha Maricle broke Ruth Anderson's old record (Ruth is our only Running Hall of Fame member) with a time of 2:23:06. Keep the shortened course in mind in considering these new records. A new award category, that of 1st woman finisher 60 or older was won by Helen Klein, 61 years old in a time of 3:10:21. Walt believes this record will stand for many years. For five hours, the dirty wet people crossed the finish line - all grateful to be "home".

Walt was in fine form at the Awards Ceremony. The National Trophy Company donated the trophies as always. Marsha gave Walt the computed times which he read without the aid of a siren. That's another record! The conclusion of this story is easy. All commuters enjoyed B.B.Q. & beer, sun, salt water, old friends and new. Thank you D.S.E.
